Thank you so everyone who participated in the fundraising events this year. We raised just over \$100 for Family Shelter Service.



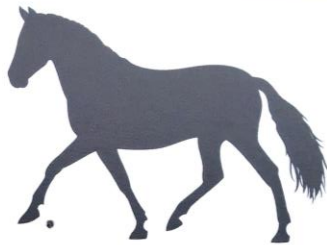
# May Gala Kentucky Derby Party

## **What is Community Outreach?**

*Community Outreach is a part of our club that focuses on helping the local community through volunteering and supply donations. There are many organizations that we have supported over the years. Some of the opportunities allow our families to participate while others become Girl's Day Out!*



**July 2017** we organized our first school supply drive to help low income students in District 200 and DuPage County. For the entire month of July school supplies were dropped off with the **People Resource Center in Wheaton** before school was back in session in August.
